A Decade of Convening Africa's Health Security Community

The African Conference on One Health and Biosecurity is an established platform for bringing together experts and stakeholders working across One Health, infectious diseases, biosecurity, biosafety, health security, biotechnology, vaccines, data and emerging biological threats.

The first African conference was held in Dakar, Senegal, in 2015, during the Ebola outbreak. It resulted in the Dakar Declaration and Resolutions. Since then, the conference has been convened annually across Africa, creating a platform for dialogue, knowledge exchange, networking and collaboration.

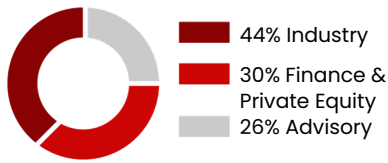

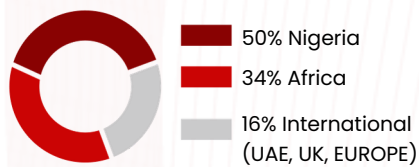

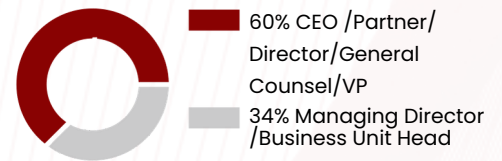
